

FHSAA Lacrosse Headgear Approved List

As a reminder, effective at the beginning of the 2018 sport season, during all interscholastic competition, all girls lacrosse field players are **required** to wear protective headgear that meets the current ASTM standard for women's lacrosse (ASTM 3137) set forth by US Lacrosse. Please note, in accordance with NFHS Girls Lacrosse rule 2-7-3 field players wearing headgear during competition shall only be allowed to wear headgear that meet the current ATSM standard for women's lacrosse and must be labeled accordingly and any headgear manufactured on or after January 1st, 2018 must be permanently labeled with the SEI certification mark. Additionally, in accordance with FHSAA Administrative Procedure 4.9.1.1.1, all girls lacrosse field players are **required** to wear protective headgear that meets the current ASTM standard for women's lacrosse during all competition.
