IN CASE YOU MISSED IT:

FHSAA OFF-SEASON & SUMMER GUIDELINES

As of April 20, 2020, all FHSAA affiliated events have been cancelled for spring sports.

For clarification regarding summer, "Summer" is now defined as:

"That period of time outside the FHSAA sports year. This period for each member school is defined as beginning the day following the school's last day of classes for the spring semester or June 1 for schools whose last day of classes for the spring semester occurs on May 31 or thereafter, and concluding with the Saturday prior to fall sports beginning, as established in the FHSAA Planning Calendar." (FHSAA Policy 20)

The FHSAA will regulate the following:

- Florida Statute requires strict adherence to FHSAA Policies 40, 41, 42 and 43.
- All students participating must have a current pre-participation evaluation (EL2) on file with the member school as required by F.S. 1002.20(17)(b) and FHSAA Bylaw 9.7.1.
- All students participating must have a current consent and release of liability certificate on file with the member school as required by FHSAA Bylaw 9.8.1.
- Activities shall be limited to a member school's own students - FHSAA Policy 20.1.1.
- Football shall follow the regulations listed in FHSAA Policy 20.1.2 regarding the use of equipment.

Due to the current pandemic, it is expected that all member schools follow Federal, State, Local and CDC recommendations and guidelines for the welfare of all involved.
