



2018-19 Event Sanction Fees for Third Party Direct Contract with FHSAA

A Third Party Direct Event is any high school athletic event conducted by a corporation or promoter involving one or more FHSAA member schools or one or more NFHS member schools (from outside the State of Florida) or any combination thereof, where the event sponsor is requesting an FHSAA or NFHS sanction of the event.

These events may not be sanctioned by an FHSAA member school. The Corporation or Promoter is required to request sanction of the event directly with the FHSAA and is responsible to pay the sanction fee directly to the FHSAA. Fees for these events are listed below.

The corporation or promoter must enter into a written agreement with the FHSAA providing terms, proof of insurance and fee to be provided to the FHSAA in exchange for FHSAA's official sanction of the event.

FEES for Third Party Direct Events

In sports where Girls and Boys teams from the same school are competing in the event, each gender, and each level (Freshman, JV, Varsity) constitutes a team.

1. Fees for Non-Broadcast events (without live or delay TV, webcast, or pay for view):

Football shall be as follows:

Classics, or Jamborees, or NFHS sanctioned events - \$1,150 for every team.

Baseball, Basketball, Volleyball, Soccer, Softball and Wrestling shall be as follows:

Tournaments, or Preseason Classics, or Jamborees – \$50 for every team.

Cross Country, Swimming & Diving, Track & Field, and Boys Weightlifting shall be as follows:

Tournaments, or Preseason Classics, or Jamborees– \$25 for every team.

Bowling, Cheerleading, Flag Football, Lacrosse, and Girls Weightlifting, Water Polo or any other sport not listed above shall be as follows:

Tournaments, or Preseason Classics, or Jamborees – \$15 for every team.

2. Events held by colleges or universities shall be as follows:

Events not charging entry or admission fee - \$300, events charging entry or admission fee - \$600

3. Fees for Broadcast events (live or delay TV, webcast or pay for view) = 1.5 times the fee schedule for Non-Broadcast events listed above.
