<b>Background Information:</b>			
Currently, all teams that advance in the state series do so on an automatic basis based upon place in each round. This process allows teams to qualify for state from weak regions and districts thus slowing down pace of play with extraordinarily high scores and increased wear and tear on host courses.			
<b>Recommendation:</b>			
Add an at-large component for advancement purposes based upon a rank established using score, course rating, and slope from the previous round.			
<p>Advancement to be as follows:</p> <p>District to Region</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Automatic – First 3 teams and First 3 individuals not on the advancing teams.</li> <li>▪ At-large – NONE</li> </ul> <p>Region to State</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Automation – First 3 teams and First 3 individuals not on the advancing teams</li> <li>▪ At-large – Next 4 teams and next 4 individuals regardless of region based upon a formula that includes 18-hole score, USGA Course Rating, and course slope.</li> </ul>			
<b>Rationale:</b>			
Increase the quality and depth of competition in the state championship series.
