**Item:** Throwing Program

**Recommendation:** Schools should be allowed to have a throwing program at the same time as preseason conditioning. Supervised players can only play catch for purpose of preparing their arm for tryouts. There can be no baseball activity other than playing catch with the exception of pitchers and catchers. Pitchers can throw from the mound and catchers can use catchers gear.

---

**Rationale:** Players are hurting their arms in tryouts and early intrasquad games due to lack of preseason arm conditioning. No matter how much you ask a players to play catch on their own, many fail to do it enough. Catchers are not available when they are not in site of the coaches. Arm care should be done in front of coaches to make sure their players are not getting arm injuries.
