#### I. Introduction and Purpose

- Robbie Lindeman welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 10:00 A.M. in the Dorothy Brunson Conference Center at FHSAA. In attendance were Juanita Hitt (Hagerty), Brian Wheatley (Venice), Stephanie Martin (FACA), Jennifer Darty (Oviedo), Dr. Angie Strickland (Leon), Carrie Lundy (Canterbury), Trudy Andrews (Columbia), Robbie Lindeman (FHSAA), and Courtney Hughes (FHSAA).
  - Brian nominated to be the chairperson for the meeting
  - Motion seconded by Carrie Lundy

#### II. Review Procedures, Agenda, and Expense Vouchers

#### III. Review Old Agenda

- Officials Travel
  - Everyone agreed that it worked best sending all four officials from the same association for the entire State Finals Tournament
  - Everyone agreed the consistency worked and is important
- Schedule
  - Stephanie Martin said players are used to playing two or more times a week, and that playing once a week is too long between games
- 7-7-1
  - Brian Wheatley mentioned this rule gives a disadvantage to the home team because it takes longer to clean-up than 1 minute. Discussed maybe stopping the clock or changing it to 7-1-7
  - Robbie Lindeman said he will bring it up in the Officials Advisory Committee Meeting
- Brian asked if anyone wanted to make changes to old agenda
  - Unanimous vote: no changes need to be made to old agenda

#### IV. New Business

- Robbie Lindeman asked if everyone was in favor of the new agenda
  - Unanimous vote to approve
- 2017 Girls Volleyball State Championships Review
  - Robbie Lindeman commended Duval County Schools for their great volunteers and staff. Robbie says it was one of the best run tournaments. Angie and Brian, who participated in the State Championships, thought the venue was great and the event was nicely run. There were 9 matches in 3 days.
  - Practice Courts- Brian says to have more than just one practice court. Robbie mentioned the reason there was only one practice court this year because the host school had a preplanned event on the other courts.
  - Fans- Brian mentioned fans seemed to have a great time.
- Officials Training
  - Robbie mentions he has a goal to get all volleyball officials on the same page learning the same things. He mentions developing a team to develop a curriculum to teach to all



volleyball officials across the state. The goal is for officials to keep learning and developing.

- FACA recommendations
  - Stephanie Martin discusses having the State Championships being a final four.
  - Stephanie Martin mentions more coaches would potentially come to the clinics it was in January instead of summer. They could also make it mandatory. To build the sport, you have to educate the coaches. Angie mentions possibly having the clinic directly after the season when coaches are free to travel, or at the championship event itself. Stephanie discussed the possibility of an incentive for the coaches to attend such as a State Series Pass.

#### V. Compliance and Eligibility Update

- Craig Damon (FHSAA) entered the room to discuss some eligibility rules concerning home school students and non-traditional students. Also discusses the Good Cause Policy.
- Robbie Lindeman mentions that no trainings are allowed for officials until after volleyball's official start date.

#### VI. Round Table Discussion

- Robbie mentions the FHSAA website will say only "TBA" until a venue and dates are secured
- Robbie mentions adding district games to MaxPreps
- Dawn Jones, a volleyball coach, brought attention to a rule from Indiana she thought was beneficial. The rule was that a player could play in both JV and Varsity games in the same night as long as only 5 sets were played in total between both games.
  - No one agreed with this presented rule stating that it would be hard to keep track
